Welcome to the Port Coquitlam Minor Softball Association Ice Breaker Tournament. The Purpose of this tournament will be to have fun playing softball, and to start a great year of softball with a few warm-up games. We expect all coaches, players, and parents to remember that this tournament is about good sportsmanship and fun.

Rules

- Please remember, this is not the World Series. Help make great memories for your team!!
- Each teams will play a minimum of 3 games
- All games will have a time limit in effect. No new inning will begin after 1 hour and 20 minutes. The game is over at 1 hour 35 minutes. If the inning is not finished, the score reverts back to the last complete inning. If the home team is ahead after visitors bat in the last inning [the inning in progress at 1hr, 20min] the home team does **not** bat.
- 5 run maximum every inning.
- Home and away status will be decided by a double coin toss at home plate prior to the start of each game.
- Pitchers will be allowed 5 warm-up pitches to start the game and 3 warm-ups in subsequent innings. No outfield balls.
- If an umpire is not assigned, the home team will supply the Home plate umpire and Away team will supply the Base umpire.
- Friday Night Games require both teams to set up the field prior to play. (and rake up after game)
